The court will open on the 13th August 2019

In the week 13^{th} - 18^{th} August 2019, the court will be used exclusively by the residents who helped on the initial cleanup days (as well as Charlotte Gibbons). This will be a trial week to iron out any initial issues.

The process will be as follows.

- 1) Fairfield Residents <u>must first</u> book an hour slot on our website <u>farifieldhall.net</u>, by going to tennis court booking (FHMC directors have the right to cancel at anytime.)
- 2) The first time residents use the court, they must go to Fairfield Community Hall to show ID and proof of address. Here, Membership must be paid in cash ideally in exact change.

2019 Cost

£6pp for adults

£3pp for concessions (under 16 and over 60)

If you sign up between 13th August and 23rd August the cost will be reduced by £1 per person.

This will give unlimited tennis for the rest of 2019.

Fairfield Community Hall

The Fairfield Community Hall will be open to receive money for memberships from the 13th August and then every Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday & Friday 9 am - 1pm.

- 3) Please read over the rules of use, GDPR guidelines and sign a Membership with your name and Fairfield address to confirm agreement.
- 4) You will then be given the code to open the lock. Please ensure you lock up after use. The code will change on a regular basis and will be emailed to all Members as and when it is updated.

NB: FHMC Directors can choose to close the court at anytime without notice.

Any proof of damage to the court will be charged accordingly to the relevant resident.
